## **ELIGIBILITY**

**Junior:** Open to any player who has not reached his/her 18th birthday before 1st January 2025.

**Open:** Open to any player regardless of age

**Note:** a player may only enter one category.

## **ENTRY**

**Submission:** Registration form must be completed and submitted:

- Select events, then I Love Chess 2025. Complete and submit the registration form.
- Onsite in paper form from 11:00 - 11:45 a.m.

Fees are payable on-site until 11:45 a.m.

## **RULES:**

Pairings will be done automatically by the Swiss Manager software based on the FIDE -Swiss Rules.

The default time is 5 minutes after the round starts.

### Tie-Break System:

1. Buchholz Cut 1
2. Buchholz
3. Sonneborn Berger
4. Progressive Score
5. Direct Encounter

The Tournament Director & Chief Arbiter can agree to change the format before the beginning of the tournament if needed, depending on the number of players entered.

No mobile phones, laptops, tablets, or other smart devices (including watches) will be allowed in the play area.

By registering for this event, players acknowledge that they have read, understood, and agreed to the tournament regulations.
