

TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

System & Time Control:

The Open Tournament will be played under a **9-round Swiss system**, with **90 minutes + 30 seconds increment per move.**

The U2000 Tournament will be played under a **7-round Swiss system**, with **90 minutes + 30 seconds increment per move.**

Tiebreaks:

- Buchholz Cut 1
- Buchholz
- Sonneborn-Berger
- Sum of Progressive Scores

Tolerance: 30 minutes after the scheduled start time. A **no-show** may result in disqualification unless the Chief Arbiter is advised before the start of the round.

Electronic and Communication Devices: During the game, it is forbidden to carry or use electronic and communication devices (smartwatch, tablet, cell phone). Failure to comply with the measure will be penalized with the loss of the game.

Conduct: Participants are required to maintain a professional demeanour throughout this high-level competition and adhere to the Bahamas Chess Code of Ethics. Any instances of collusion, pre-arrangement of results, or other violations of the FIDE Laws of Chess or established decorum will prompt the Organizer to take necessary actions. This may involve reporting the incident to FIDE and Bahamas Chess, potentially affecting the player's eligibility for future invitations.

Byes: One half-point bye per player is permitted in rounds 1-5. Requests must be submitted to the Chief Arbiter by the end of round 4.

Attire: Players are encouraged to wear whatever is comfortable during the tournament. However, sunglasses, hoodies, sports caps, ripped jeans, camouflage and revealing attire are not allowed.



Draw by mutual agreement: Players may not draw a game by agreement before the completion of black's 30th move. A claim for a draw before the completion of black's 30th move is permitted only in cases of draw by threefold repetition or a stalemate.

Awards: Cash prizes will be paid to players present at the closing ceremony (immediately after the final round). Cash Prizes will be paid in USD.

In the case of a tie, the **prize money will be divided among players with equal scores**, up to the 5th place based on the tie-break criteria.

Rights: The organizers reserves the right to modify game schedules with prior official notice to participants.
