Game in 60 minutes +30 seconds / move

2 PLAYERS WILL QUALIFY FOR OPEN AND WOMAN TEAM

**Format** – The tournament will be in a Swiss format. Games will be 60 minutes plus 30 seconds increment per move.

## **Eligibility**

The tournament is open to any Bahamian of any age who is also a member of the Bahamas Chess Federation. To be eligible a player may join BCF or renew his/her membership before or during the final registration.

**Registration** - Players are encouraged to preregister ONLINE at <a href="https://www.bahamaschessfederation.org/1st-olympiad-qualifier-2024.html">https://www.bahamaschessfederation.org/1st-olympiad-qualifier-2024.html</a>. Final registration will be held at the venue, starting at 8:15 am and ending at 8:45 am on February 10<sup>th</sup>. Those wanting to pay in person can pay at the venue before the start of Round 1.

### **Entry Fee** – \$20

**Prizes** – Since this is a qualifying tournament the prize is 'Qualification' for the Open or Woman's Olympiad Team.

#### Qualification

The top two (2) Open finishers, determined by tie-breaks if necessary, will qualify for the 2024 Olympiad Team

The top two (2) female finishers, determined by tie-breaks if necessary, will qualify for the 2024 Olympiad Team

#### Tie-Breaks:

- 1) Direct encounter
- 2) Greater number of wins
- 3) Greater number of games as Black;
- 4) Buchholz

#### **Additional Regulations**

- The FIDE Laws of Chess will govern the tournament.
- The default time is 30 minutes after the round has started. If a player defaults to two games in the event, they may be withdrawn from the tournament at the Arbiter's discretion.
- Mobile phones, laptops, tablets, and other smart devices must be switched off and cannot be used at any time during the match.
- Recording of all game moves is mandatory.

- 2. By registering for this event, players acknowledge that they have read, understood, and agreed to the tournament regulations.
